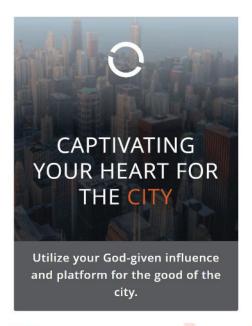

2. It is a journey, not loose standing events

- ✓ At least 8/9 gatherings of at least 4 hours
- ✓ At least one retreat early in the journey
- ✓ A graduation event where every participant receives a plated brick

3. Mechanisms used to inform the journey

Jesus Journey // Case Studies // Expert Speakers // Alumni in the news (stories)

4. Commissioning interviews

Facilitate the next step for Lifework participants out of the Journaling and Circle Charts after completion of the program

- √ Feedback about the program
- ✓ 3 Future Life-workers recommended

5. Small groups journey within the larger group

- ✓ The group of between 30 and 60 will be divided into small groups
- ✓ Smaller groups (±7) must be encouraged to meet in between the gatherings for relationship building and further processing
- ✓ Ample time for processing in the groups during the retreat and events to enhance understanding, application and accountability.
- ✓ Small group coaches must be trained to facilitate discussions.

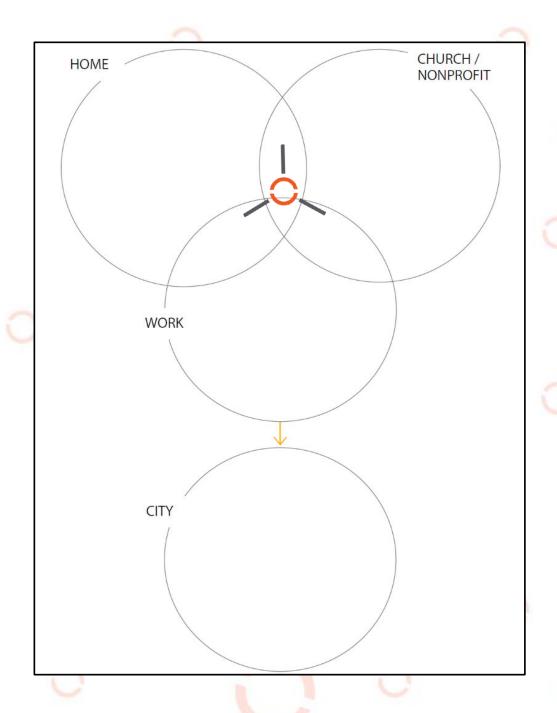
 Include the 4-chapter gospel and love paradigm in the training.

6. One to one with the Executive Director once a year

The executive director needs to have an individual meeting with every participant at least once a year to get feedback on the program as well as to explore how the participant can be empowered for their contribution towards the transformation of the city.

7. Journey application facilitated with the Circle Charts

- ✓ Have journaling time in the gathering before the small group discussions
- ✓ Time for personal application in the circle chart below (Leverage)



8. Optional: Reflecting on their personal journey (Outcomes)

- ✓ Calling What action steps do you need to take this week to better integrate your faith with everyday life?
- ✓ Community What connections have you made in the group that needs investment of your time?
- ✓ City What opportunities can you identify to utilize your Godgiven influence and platform for the good of the city?
